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Institutional Admission Analysis & Statistical Report

Executive Overview

This report provides a comprehensive overview and analysis of historical undergraduate (UG) course admissions at ASR Homoeopathic Medical College spanning the academic cycles from 2017-18 to 2025-26. The data outlines shifting trends in intake capacities, utilization rates across Government and Management quotas, vacancy patterns, and regulatory compliance indicators.

1. Key Insights & Enrollment Trends

- Growth in Demand & Capacity Expansion:** The institution has consistently maintained an annual intake of 100 seats in recent years, demonstrating an expanded baseline compared to the 60-seat baseline observed in 2020-21. Notably, there were zero admissions recorded during the 2017-18 and 2018-19 blocks, indicating an operational gap or a subsequent re-launch phase.
- Quota Distribution Analysis:** In the most recent 2025-26 academic term, Government Quota admissions remained stable at 55 seats, while Management Quota recruitment saw a localized dip to 17 seats, leaving 28 vacant positions. This contrasts with the 2024-25 cycle, where peak efficiency was achieved with 37 Management seats filled and only 8 remaining vacant.
- Regulatory Compliance:** Across all active historical records, zero students were admitted via Court Orders, highlighting seamless compliance with state selection committees and institutional regulatory frameworks.
